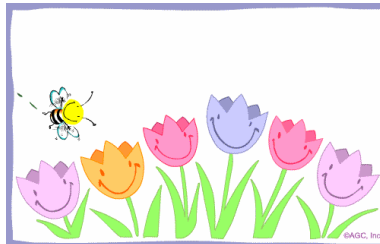

The Village Hall will be closed Monday, May 26th in observance of Memorial Day



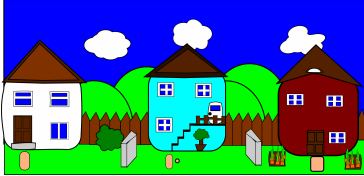
