<u>Winter Parking</u> Our ordinance states that there is NO parking between 4am and 8am from Nov. 1st through April 15th for snow removal. Dog License Now is the time to get your 2024 Jackson County dog license. You will need to provide current rabies vaccine information for each dog to be licensed. The fee for unaltered dogs is \$12.00 and the fee for spayed or neutered dogs is \$7.00. There will be a \$5.00 late fee added after March 31st 2024.

SNOW REMOVAL

The Village would like to remind everyone that sidewalks need to be cleared <u>of ICE and</u> <u>snow within 24 hours</u> <u>after a snowfall</u>. If the Village is required to clear the sidewalk the homeowner will be charged \$300.00 and could be assessed a fine of \$515.00.

Please do not push the snow into the street or the sidewalk when plowing your driveway.
